Theme for this workshop:
Immigrants and new groups

1. Welcome by NON (the Outdoor project) and Svenskt Friluftsliv. (15 min)
2. How five organizations in Sweden have been working during the last years with immigrants and new groups; Scouterna, Sportfiskarna, Friluftsrådet, Naturskyddsföreningen och Turistföreningen. (50 min)
3. MUCF - Swedish Agency for Youth and Civil Society. (30 min) Nongovernmental organizations as a resource for immigrants to establish contact with society.
4. Working in groups: (30 min)
What are our common visions, challenges and needs, looking into the future? (wish list) How can the Nordic cooperation contribute to immigrants with activities during their sparetime and how to we better reach new groups?
5. Lunch together with an outdoor activity. (90 min)
6. Immigrants and new groups – examples from Norway, Finland and Denmark. Best case, and learning examples. (60 min)
7. Break with fruit and coffee/the. (20 min)
8. One example of the effect of outdoor activity - on a personal level. (20 min)
9. Working in groups: (60 min)
What will enhance immigrants and new groups to use nature more and on their own?
10. Summary and presentations from working groups with recommendations and needs for the future. (30 min)
11. Collective dinner for those who have the opportunity to stay at 19:00.

Practical information:

- The four workshops will be separate sessions. Invitees will be selected in accordance to the topic of each session with the aim of ensuring informed debate, useful sharing of ideas and new knowledge. You do not need to attend more than one workshop.
- Workshops will be one-day events.
- Each workshop will have among 30 participants, with all 4 countries present. Normally, there will be more attendees from the host country than from those traveling there. Additional invitees who carry their own costs are welcome.
- Youth and youth NGOs will be involved in the in planning and implementation of workshops.
- Youth are defined aged between 16-26 years old.
- NON and the Outdoor project covers travel cost for the participants.
- Each country coordinates their participants.
